ELECTRICITY (e.g., BC Hydro) Set up service or transfer accounts.	CANADA POST Set up mail forwarding to catch anything missed.
NATURAL GAS (e.g., FortisBC)	GOVERNMENT AGENCIES Update your driver's license, health card, and vehicle registration.
Arrange for service connection or transfer. WATER & SEWER Confirm with your municipality or strata.	FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS Notify banks, credit card companies, and investment providers.
INTERNET & CABLE Schedule installation or transfer.	INSURANCE PROVIDERS Update your home, auto, and life insurance.
HOME SECURITY SYSTEMS Update your address and contact information.	EMPLOYERS & PAYROLL Ensure your workplace has your correct address.
WASTE & RECYCLING Arrange for bin delivery if needed.	SUBSCRIPTION SERVICES Update addresses for streaming services, magazines, and memberships.



Start the transfer process 2-4 weeks before moving day to avoid interruptions. Keep a list of important phone numbers and account details handy. Use a master checklist to track completed steps.
